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### **Safety Precautions**



- This appliance is for indoor use only.
- Do not put washing machine at humid place.
- Hands must not be inserted into running spin-dry tub.
- If the spin-dry tub does not stop within 15seconds after opening the cover, please stop using the machine and have it repaired.
- Before doing any maintenance and repair, unplug the appliance from the socket.
- Always unplug the machine and turn off the water supply after use.
- To ensure safety, check carefully and make sure that your socket is properly and reliably earthed.
- Make sure that the water and electrical devices must be connected by a qualified technician in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and local safety regulations.
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### **Safety Precautions**



- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- The openings must not be obstructed by a carpet.
- Remove all packages before using the appliance.
- Plug must be accessible after installation.
- Do not climb up and sit on top cover of the machine.
- The washing machine with single inlet valve only can be connected to the cold water supply. The product with double inlet valves should be correctly connected to the hot water and cold water supply.
- Do not lean against machine door.
- · Cautions during Handling:
- 1. Transport bolts shall be reinstalled to the machine by a specialized person.
- 2. The accumulated water shall be drained out of the machine.
- Handle the machine carefully. Never hold each protruded part on the machine while lifting. Machine door can not be used as the handle during the conveyance.
- 4. This appliance is heavy. Transport with care.
- $\bullet \ \ \text{Before washing clothes the first time, run the machine in one round cycle empty}.$
- Do not wash or dry articles contaminated with combustible or explosive substances (such as wax, oil, paint, gasoline, degreasers, dry-cleaning solvents, kerosene, etc.) This may result in fire or explosion.
- Select detergents suitable for machine washing, especially for drum.
- Sharp and hard items such as coin, brooch, nail, screw or stone etc. must be removed from the clothes to prevent serious damage to the machine.
- Please do not open the door if there is still water visible. Open the door once the water has been completely drained.
- Be careful when the machine drains hot washing water to prevent scalding.
- Never fill water by hand during washing.
- After the program is completed, please wait for two minutes before opening the door.



### **UNPACKING THE WASHING MACHINE**

- Packaging material (e.g. films, styrofoam) can be dangerous for children.
- There is a risk of suffocation. Keep all packaging away from children.
- Remove the cardboard box and styrofoam packing.
- Lift the washing machine and remove the base packing.
- Remove the tape securing the power supply cord and drain hose.
- Remove the inlet hose from the drum.









### **INSTALLATION AREA**

- Make sure that the washer is on a stable position to prevent the product from moving.
- Make sure that the product should not stand on the power cord.
- Before installing the machine, select an area considering the following:
- 1. Rigid, dry, and level surface.
- 2. Avoid direct sunlight.
- 3. Sufficient ventilation.
- 4. Room temperature is above 0°C.
- 5. Keep far away from the heat resources such as coal or gas.








- Do not twist or curve the drain hose.
- Position drain hose properly to prevent water leakage.
- If drain hose is too long, do not force it into washing machine as it will cause abnormal noise.

There are two ways to place the end of drain hose:



### LEVELLING THE WASHING MACHINE

- The lock nuts on all four feet must be screwed tightly against the housing.
- 1. Check if the legs are closely attached to the cabinet. If not, please turn them to their original positions and tighten the nuts.
- 2. Check alignment of the product with a level and align if required.
- 3. Loosen the lock nut and turn the feet until it closely contacts with the floor.
- 4. After being locked properly, press four corners again to make sure that they has been adjusted properly.



### CONNECTION OF INLET HOSE, FAUCET AND WASHING MACHINE


1. Connection between ordinary faucet and inlet hose.

Loosen four bolts




Set connecting base on the faucet and tighten bolts evenly




Tighten clamp nut



Press slide bushing, insert inlet hose into connecting base




Connection finished


### PREPARATIONS BEFORE WASHING

### () CAUTION

- Before washing, please make sure that the washer is properly installed.
- Before washing it at first time, the washing machine shall be operated in one full cycle without clothes in it following the procedure below except #3. Then include #3 in the procedure once actual washing is to be done.



### **Operations**

- The working condition of the washer should be (0-40)°C.
- Please check the labels and the explanation on detergent use before washing. Non-foaming or less-foaming detergent is suitable for use in this machine.


### WASHING


After washing has finished, buzzer sounds and the power supply will cut off automatically. Unload the laundry.

- Washing one piece of cloth may easily cause great eccentricity and alarm with sound due to unbalanced load. To prevent this, it is suggested to add one or two more clothes to be washed together so that draining can be done smoothly.
- Do not wash clothes with kerosene, gasoline, alcohol and other flammable materials.

### **USAGE OF DETERGENT AND WASHING POWDER**

- Dilute semi solid (agglomerated) detergent before placing them into the detergent box to prevent blocking of the inlet which may cause back flow while filling water.
- Please choose suitable type of detergent for the various washing temperature to get the best washing performance with less water and energy consumption.

### **Control Panel**



**Note:** The chart is for illustration only. There might be a slight difference with the actual unit purchased.

- On / Off
  Product is switched on or off.
- Start / Pause Press the button to start or pause the washing cycle.
- 3 Program
  Available according to the laundry type.
- Option
  This allows you to select an additional function and will light when selected.
- 5 **Display**The display shows the settings, estimated time remaining, options, and status messages for your washer. The display will remain on through the cycle.

When LED flashing, it means the time that delay to start the machine. When LED lighting it means the program time that remaining. When the number/s on LED display is blinking, delay function is in operation. When the number/s on LED display is steady, it is the remaining time of the cycle.

### WATER LEVEL

Select water level according to clothing categories, degree of soiling and washing habits of customers.







#### WASH/RINSE/SPIN

Washing time, rinsing times, spinning time and other settings can be selectable.



### **DELAY**

- 1. Select a program.
- 2. Press the "Delay" button to choose the time.
- 3. Press "Start / Pause" button to commence the delay operation.


### **Washing Program**

Customers can select washing program according to actual demand, and set washing time, rinsing times, spinning time, water volume and appointment time.

Program are available according to the laundry type.

#### **Jeans**

Suitable to wash heavy stained clothes.

#### Quick 15'

Suitable to wash light stained clothes and clothes in summer.

### Soft

Slow washing and spinning speed, to prevent wear from deformation.

#### Mix

Suitable to wash cotton, linen, flax, jute clothes.

#### Normal

Standard fabric washing program, suitable to wash ramie cotton fabric. Wash for once, rinsing for twice, the spin time is a little long.

### Strong

The wash time is longer, the stream is stronger, so the washing effect is better.

### Heavy

Suitable to wash heavy stained / wearable clothes.

### Fuzzy sensing:

The washing machine will select the water level automatically according to the load weight. Once the program, time of washing, number of times of rinsing, and spin time are set, press start button without pressing the water level. the Fuzzy sensing function will work. When there is water in the tub, this will not function.

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### T-Clean

Cleans the tub during spinning.

### Maintenance

### **CLEANING AND CARE**

Before your maintenance starts, please unplug the machine and close the faucet.

#### **CLEANING THE CABINET**


Proper maintenance on the washing machine can extend its working life. The surface can be cleaned with diluted non-abrasive neutral detergents with wet cloth then wipe it with dry clean cloth to dry. Formic acid and its diluted solvents or equivalent are forbidden, such as alcohol, solvents or chemical products, etc.

### **CLEANING THE INLET FILTER**

Inlet filter must be cleaned if there is less water.

Washing the filter in washing machine:


- 1. Screw off the inlet pipe from the backside of the machine.
- 2. Pull out the filter with long nose pliers and reinstall it back after being washed.
- 3. Use the brush to clean the filter.
- 4. Reconnect the inlet pipe.



#### Lint Filter Clean

- 1. There is a built-in lint filter in your washer. It can collect lint during washing cycle.
- 2. It is suggested to clean the lint filter every 10 cycles.
- 3. Take it out and clean the filter with water. Then place it back into the washer.






### **CLEANING DRAIN PUMP FILTER**

- Be careful of hot water.
- Allow it to cool down.
- Unplug the machine to avoid electrical shock before cleaning.
- Drain pump filter filters the yarns and small foreign matters from the washer.
- Clean the filter periodically to ensure the normal operation of washing machine.




Drain the water out of the pump. Place a container under it to collect the water




Open the filter by turning counter clockwise




Remove collected pins, screws, etc

Tighten the pump cover by turning it clockwise

### () CAUTION

- Make sure that valve cap and emergency drain hose are reinstalled properly, cap plates should be inserted aligning to hole plates otherwise water may leak.
- Some machines do not have emergency drain hose, so step2 and step3 can be skipped. Rotate lower cover cap directly to make water run into basin.
- When the appliance is using hot water, never remove the pump cover during a wash cycle, always wait until the appliance has finished the cycle and is empty. When replacing the cover, ensure it is securely tightened.

### **Troubleshooting**

When the machine has not started or has stopped operating, try to find a solution first by referring to the items listed below:

Problem	Causes
Does not start washing	If the power is off or the fuse is damage.  If the power supply voltage is too low.  If the water amount reaches to the required water level. (The washer will not work if the water amount does not reach the required water level).  If it is set to "Delay" washing mode. (It will only start to work until the set number of hours is reached).
Not filling water	If the power is off or the fuse is damage.  Without water supply or the water pressure is too low.  If the inlet hose is properly connected and the faucet is opened.  If the filtering screen of inlet valve is blocked by dirt.  If the coil of inlet valve is damaged. (The slight electromagnetic sound is normal phenomenon when the inlet valve is switched on).  If the "Start/Pause" button is pressed after the power switch is pressed.
Abnormal draining	If the water drain hose is placed very high.  If the end of water drain hose is blocked.  If the internal rubber ring of drain valve is blocked by dirt.
Abnormal spin	If the door lid is closed.  If there is unbalanced load.  If the washer is not placed in stable condition or it is placed in inclination state. (The ground is not flat).  If the motor belt is loosened.
